Leila remembered in style Milestones for Genever and Heal

Leila's Run

This annual event, featuring 10K, half marathon and marathon options celebrates the life of Leila Taylor, a much-loved member of GCR. The event was organised by DENYS BAUDRY and DAVE LEWIS, with support from fantastic volunteers around the course, which features a scenic six and a half mile loop from Wheathampstead, following trail routes covered by Leila on her training runs. This year's event saw runners experiencing a range of weather systems, with pouring rain in the morning and then the sun breaking through the clouds after midday. Fittingly, as Leila was a member of the 100 marathon club and had run over 200 marathons in her lifetime, this year's event saw GCR marathon ace NICK GENEVER (pictured below, left, with DAVE HEAL) achieve his goal of running 200 marathons in three years.



Nick writes: "After completing my 100th marathon at Leila's Run in 2016, I set myself the target of reaching 200 in three years. Today at Leila's Run I completed my 200th marathon in 4:01:42. In three years that's 9 trail ultras, 91 trail marathons, 2710 race miles, 43 miles

of ascent, ultras in Vancouver, Niagara, Tromso, and races all over England, two in Wales and one in Northern Ireland."

Another milestone was reached by DAVE HEAL, completing his 40th marathon at the same event – Dave reports:

"I chose Leila's run to celebrate my 40th marathon as Leila was very inspirational to me when I joined Garden City Joggers (as it was then known) in 2001. Leila would always have a chat about her remarkable journey to joining the 100 Marathon club, and I couldn't think of a better way to celebrate my 40th in memory of a lovely lady, sadly missed by many many runners in Garden City runners and further afield! I found it tough today after the last two weeks of ultras, so it was all about getting around. I got a watch time of 5:28:15 and was glad to finish and proud as punch to be presented with a fantastic Leila's Run medal by Denys Baudry."

Results were not available at the time of going to press, so all times reported here are unofficial. GCRs taking part in the 10K event included DANIEL PUDNER, who was first to cross the finish line in 44:56, as well as ALI RIZA EROGLU, JERRY GILBERT (finishing in 1:08:32), MAGGIE WRIGHT, CHARLOTTE JONES and HANNAH BEE, walking with her trusty companion PIXIE the dog. In the half marathon event, PETER JASKO ran in 1:40:08 and ELEANOR NEWTON was first lady in 1:41:39, and REBECCA BARDEN and RICHARD DARLEY also took part. In the marathon distance, PETER HARVEY clocked a time of 3:19:22 and TOM WACKETT finished third with a new marathon pb of 3:22:33. KATH EVANS, ELAINE GILES, DENNIS and ELEANOR DRAPER and several other GCRs also completed the marathon distance.

Wortwell Sizzler

GCR newbie HELEN HARRISON competed in her first 'proper' race since joining GCR in November. The Wortwell sizzler is a five mile race in Suffolk, taking place on a very wet Friday night. Helen writes: "It poured with rain but I was really pleased to finish in 42.30, 96th out of 217 runners, and 23rd female."


Not Round Latrigg Fell Race
