A notable winner on the night was RUSSELL MORRIS, who secured both the Most Improved (male) Award, as well as the Club Runner of Year, voted for by club members. HELEN STAFFORD won the Most Improved Female Award. This year's winners of the highly-contested club's Avery trophies (it's like the premier league) were RICHARD SOMERSET and SOPHIE PACKMAN. This year also saw the first season of the new club champions league, won in the inaugural season by HELEN STAFFORD and PETER HARVEY.

I came home in 78:32 (chip) which was a PB by a few secs. 61st overall in 5th in age category.
Pretty happy with that given I ran without any taper in a busy final quarter of an intensive marathon training block"

Willow Gibson and **Samantha Hastie** (*pictured, below*) travelled to Poland to get their 'Z' parkrun, and finished in 35:24 and 35:45, respectively. Willow writes: "We flew to Poland late Friday evening (sadly missing the GCR awards evening, as we booked this a while ago).

We stayed in the Kraków Old Town, which is stunning and a short Uber ride out to Zielony Jar park. On Saturday morning we arrived to a team of super friendly and welcoming volunteers. The RD welcomed us and celebrated International Women's day with a yellow tulip. We did Zumba as a warm up before the start.

It's a four lapper, mostly on footpaths with a small amount on dirt paths (I wore trails but road shoes are fine - very little mud). This was event 27, so yes a very new parkrun with only 42 attending, runners, walkers and Nordic walkers (who walked at some people's running pace). Most of the parkrunners being tourists, many from the UK also.

The young volunteer, a boy named Adaś, was the star of the volunteer team and did the English part of the briefing. He was very helpful, giving out travel advice and tips for us tourists as well.

Samantha Hastie completed the Alphabet challenge today (not bad for someone who only started running parkrun in January!) Well done, Samantha!

Seventy-Six GCRs took part in Saturday's weekly run, jog or walk around the parks of the UK and beyond.

Chris Eland was 18th at Ashton Court parkrun in 20:04, and at St Albans Daniel Pudner came 17th in 20:13, followed by Nigel Cavill in 22:15 and Paul Cox in 25:49. Emon Martin, Caroline Griffin and Caroline O'Dwyer ran the Rickmansworth parkrun, in 24:29, 25:50 and 30:33, respectively.

Further afield, Sharon Threlfall travelled to Dreiländergarten and was 3rd lady in 26:01. **Nick Portalski** was 18th overall at Broadwater, in 23:56.
