<u>Tromso Polar Marathon - 7 January</u>

Anna Lillie (*pictured, below*) travelled all the way to Norway to run the Tromso Polar Marathon.

Anna writes: "Tromso Polar Marathon was truly unique. 80 participants ran, and after 21k we joined a half marathon course. It did nothing to allay my fears of: would I be good enough to run this in the cut off time of 5 hours; would I find anyone to run with; am I wearing the right clothing; would I get lost; how would I cope in the dark; should I take my running rucksack; how would my legs work in the snow and ice; trail shoes or crampons?

It was truly majestic. The full moon and clear skies with the snow, made for something truly magical – and no need for a head torch. Whilst there is around 21 hours of darkness here, so much revolves around the light. We were just dropped off in this tiny hamlet, and told to follow the road back. No markers, no marshals; an ambulance drove up and down a couple of times to check runners were OK during the first 20k.

I stupidly carried water as the drinks stops weren't frequent, but my water froze, and my gels nearly did too. I was fortunate enough to find a British lady to run the whole way with – which helped, and the fact it was freezing when you stopped. Sometimes there was no-one in sight in front or behind, and with windy snowy gusts – despite being right next to the British lady we couldn't see each other at times. Her company was very much appreciated. I completed this in 4hours 27 mins and 40 secs. Given the icy conditions and running with spikes on, I was happy"
