Festive Five

GCRs put on a great show and a great performance at the annual Festive 5, a five-mile race round WGC town centre, starting and finishing on Stanborough Green. A special shout out to always-smiling and supremely capable Race Director **Dani Pruett**, **Richard Sidlin** and **Craig** **Stephenson** for race timing and results, **Sean Bowen** for Chief Marshal duties, **Peter Harvey**, compere extraordinaire, **Caroline Sidlin**, who deftly pivoted from registration to cake stall management, **Jacqueline McCallum** for tail running and all the GCRs who volunteered, marshalled and supported before, during and after the event.

174 runners took part in the race, with Fairlands Valley Spartans scoring a 1-2 – **Andrew Patterson** finishing in 26:34 and clubmate **Simon Jackson** in 28:26. **Peter Harvey** was first GCR home, and also first MV50 and fourth overall in 29:55. **Hannah Turner** of Harpenden Arrows was first lady in 31:47; **Russell Morris** and **Steve Ellerd-Elliott** continued their excellent run of form to finish 11th in 32:51 and 12th in 32:55 respectively. Hot on their heels were **Jamie Rose**, 13th in 32:56 and **Justin Hill**, 14th in 32:58. GCR ladies stole the show with a winning team of **Zoe Stephens**, fourth female in 34:53, ladies' team captain **Hannah Frank**, fifth lady and first FS in 35:11, and **Alex Faulkner**, sixth female in a storming 35:25. Many runners entered into the Christmas spirit with festive outfits and headgear, but the prize for most commitment to the yuletide cause indisputably goes to **James McGeehan**, who propelled himself round the course wearing an almost spherical inflatable Santa suit, and still managed to finish is a very respectable 52:16.

While many were braving the freezing temperatures of central WGC, a contingent of GCRs travelled to sunny southern Spain to compete in the Valencia Marathon and Half Marathon. In the Marathon event, **Chris Eland** ran in an impressive 3:02:55, and **Anna Lillie** continued her marathon challenge with a super strong 4:01:45. In the half marathon, **Juliet Vine** was 9th in her age category FV35 in a time of 1:23:00, and **Martha Hall** 14th FV45 in 1:31:25.
