Herts Country XC Senior Championships

Nine GCRs braved weather conditions described as 'Biblical' to compete in the Herts Country Cross Country Senior Champs at Cassiobury Park, Watford, on Sunday. Runners followed a route through fields, trails, paths and boggy woods in torrential rain and, the course having already been churned up by younger runners who raced before the senior events, with extreme mud and puddles underfoot.

Lizzie Parry was first home for GCR women, running one lap of the 8K course in 30:11 to finish third overall. **Juliet Vine** was fifth in 30:37, **Martha Hall** 18th in 33:59 and **Hannah Frank** was the fourth runner in the scoring team in 38:17. GCR women finished third team overall and picked up county bronze medals. Also running for GCR women was **Rebecca Barden**, who finished in 40:50.

As the women finished their race and the rain intensified, the men set off on their two-lap 11K course. **Steve Ellerd-Elliott** took a leisurely approach to time as a construct and was seen sprinting towards the start line a full minute after the whistle had blown. First to fling their mud-splattered self over the finish line was **Chris Baylis** who ran in 46:34, then **Dom Thomas** in 50:20, **Steve Ellerd-Elliott** in 51:57 and **Nick Summers** in 53:05.

A huge thank you to all the marshals and volunteers who stood out for hours in the pouring rain to see us all safely round the course, especially our GCR marshals **Sean Bowen** and **Jacqueline McCallum** and our timing supremo **Richard Sidlin** and his Races Online team.

GCRs travelled far and wide to participate in the weekly 5km run including to one of the most difficult in the country – see Willow's report of their trip to Great Yarmouth.

At Shipley Country **Rebecca Cullers** was first lady over the line in 24:54, while at Canons Park **Alex Faulkner** was second lady in 25:41 while **Katherine Farrell** wasn't far behind, coming in fourth in 26 minutes exactly. **Jamie Rose** made up the GCR trio at this venue finishing with a time of 21:17 and sixth place overall.

At Panshanger **Chris Eland** was first GCR and sixth overall in exactly 20 minutes, while at Dunstable Downs **Andrew Holt** was second in 22:42.

Four GCRs ventured to Great Yarmouth to help **Samantha Hastie** run her 50th parkrun. Willow Gibson sent this report. "Four of us travelled to Great Yarmouth Friday evening, to celebrate Samantha's 50th parkrun! She only started in January 2022, so ran 50 in 52 weeks! Mostly at different locations each time. We attempted the hardest parkrun in the UK on a very windy but fine January morning (which the RD said was almost cancelled). The sand was fairly firm underfoot, so easy enough to run on; it was the wind and sand getting in our faces that made it tough! We loved this parkrun because of the really friendly volunteers, who were made up of locals and visitors to Great Yarmouth. Really nice route, 2 laps around the beach, with beautiful coastal views and super encouraging marshals cheering us on. Lovely local cafe, called The Beach Hut, which served delicious hot chocolates and super tasty breakfasts. Well done Samantha Hastie".
