parkrun roundup

Warm and sunny weather saw many GCRs took part in parkruns across Herts and beyond.

At Walthamstow, **Richard Somerset** and **John McDowall** (*photo below*) finished in 20:39 and 21:25, respectively. **John** writes: "We made the short drive to Walthamstow Parkrun on

Saturday 18th of February. A three and a bit laps of the Peter May Sports Ground on a course that you would be hard pushed to call scenic, it is Walthamstow after all, and one should clearly not expect the Hanging Gardens of Babylon or herds of wildebeest sweeping majestically across the plain.

Saying that it was more interesting to run than it looked. The surface is lushly grassed and was level with few dents and ruts to disturb your running foot fall. One side of the square dragged uphill, one side up-and-down, the other into a stiff headwind and the final one dodged round sports fittings. Being an open square you had a good view across to see where every one was.

Richard was home in what he felt was a disappointing 9th place (20.39) having been running in third place for most of the run. I was pleased with 11th (21.35) meaning both the GCR'ers where first and second in their age category (Vets 55-59).

No proper cafe onsite, theres a little hut that does basics but with no seating, so a two minute drive round the corner to the local cafe for some, what the locals would call, 'nosh' before heading home".
